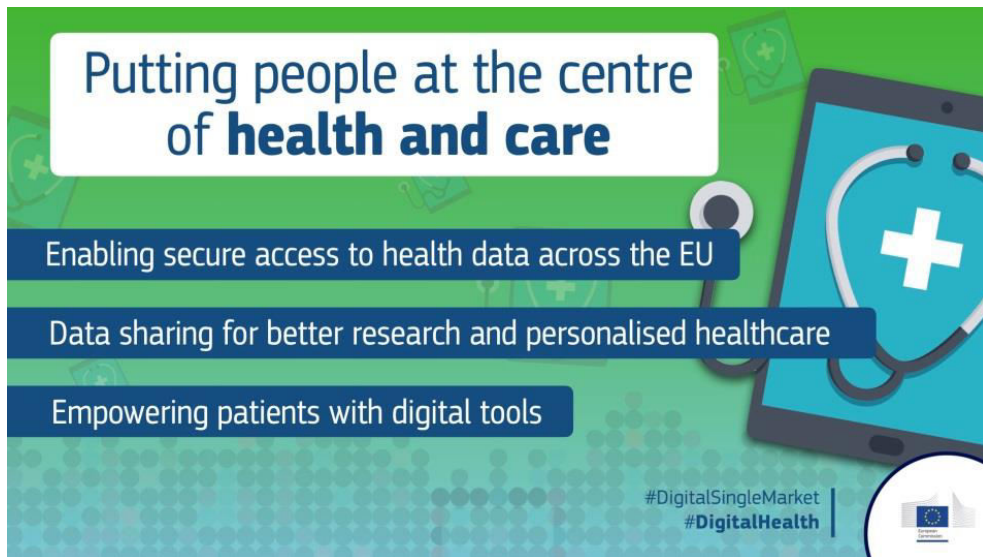

Council Conclusions on Health in the Digital Society, 8 December 2017

- Data-driven tools for **healthcare services** and sustainable health systems
- Implementation of **existing EU legislation** on the protection of personal data, electronic identification and information security
- Building on initiatives under the **Digital Single Market Strategy**: European Cloud Initiative, EuroHPC and European Open Science Cloud
- Improving **access to larger European datasets**, longitudinal data and world-class high performance computing infrastructure

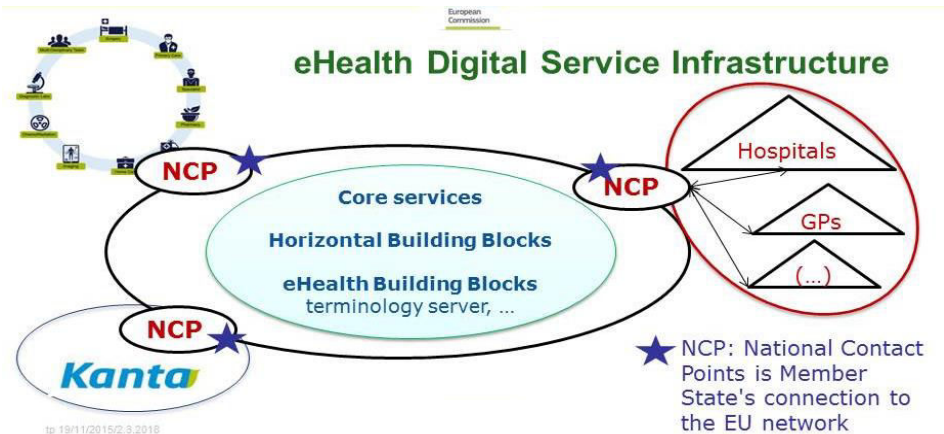
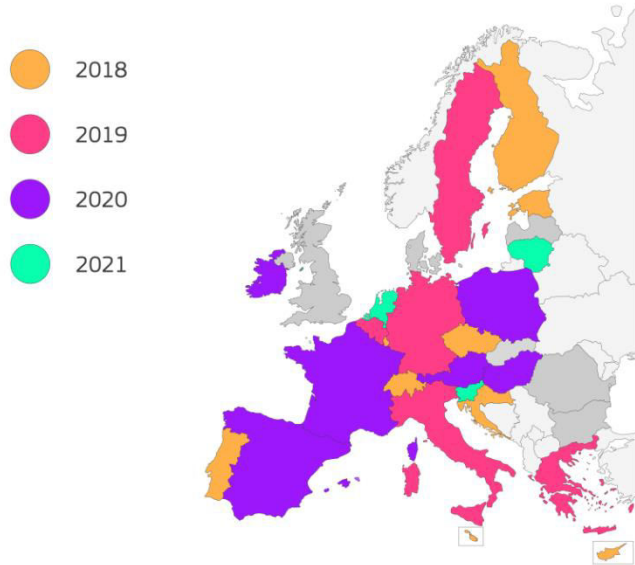

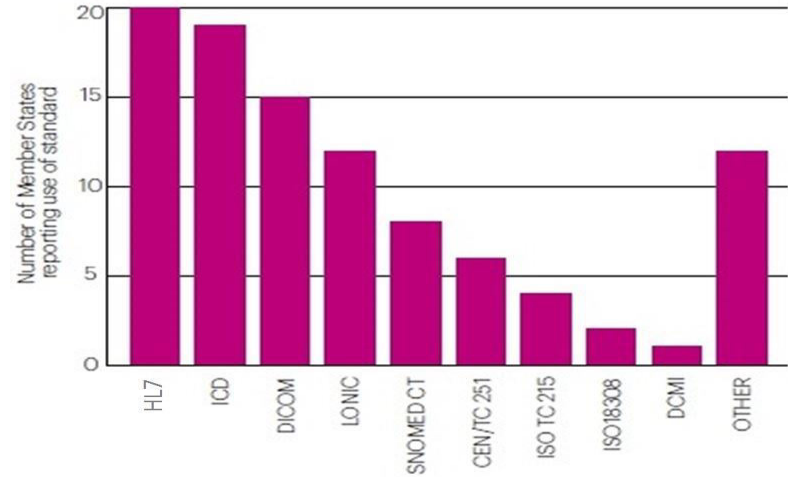
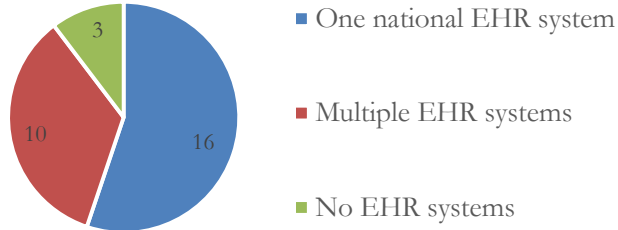
eHealth DSI builds cross-border exchange

Single national v. multiple EHR Systems in place (N=29)



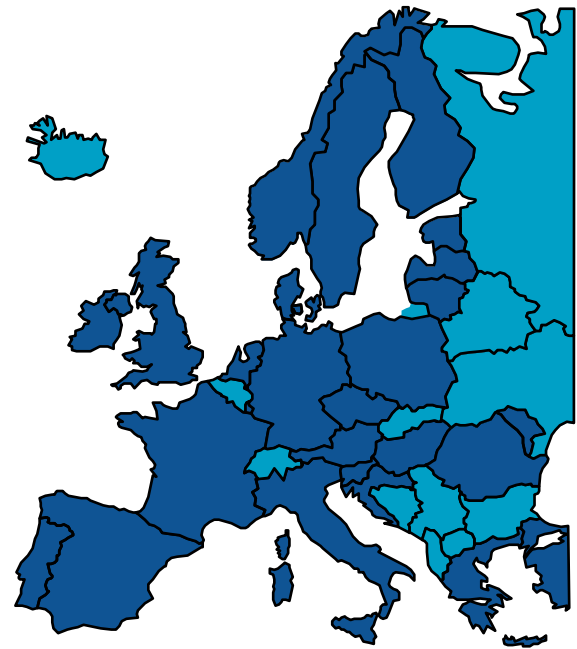
PROPOSED EU ACTION

Enable Citizen access and ability to use health data securely across-borders through the European electronic health record **exchange format**

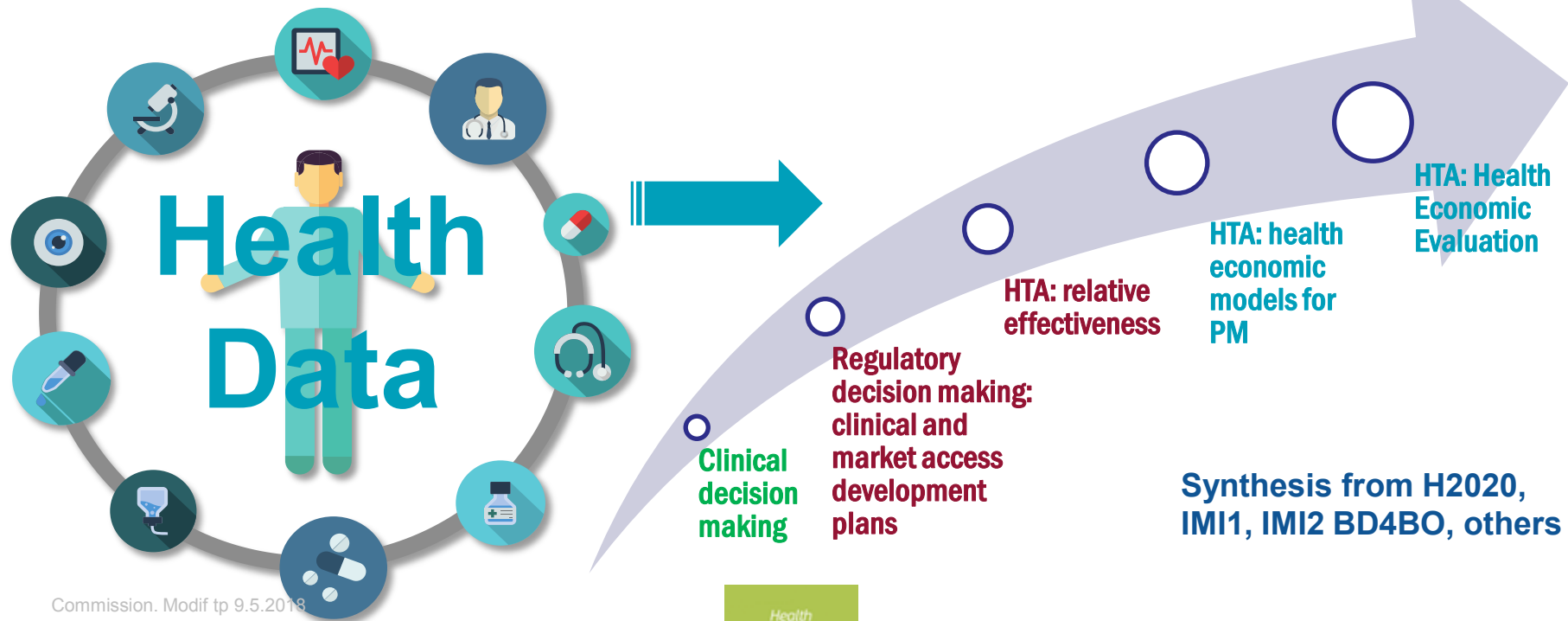

- Policy orientation for PM research

PROPOSED EU ACTION

1 million genomes by 2022
accessible through a
secure data infrastructure
*privacy and security
by design*

Declaration on 1 million sequenced genomes

- Signed by 16 Member States
- Agree to work together towards building a research cohort of at least 1 million sequenced genomes accessible in the EU
- By 2022
- Access through a federated (non-centralised) network to genomics data-sets created at national and regional levels
- Commission will support and facilitate, including funding from Horizon 2020 and CEF programmes

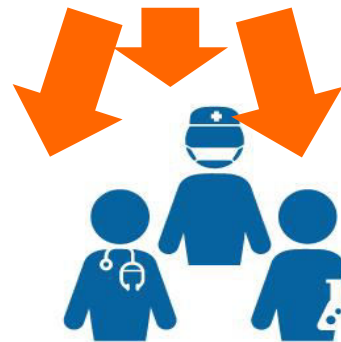
