Represent the organisation during (international) conferences (optional). Maintain a record per board member (and for any volunteers as needed) of payments such as expenses received per month . Submit income tax forms to the Dutch tax authority if needed.
Authorisations	 Purchase items needed such as paper. Take decisons in cooperation with other board members.
Responsibilities	 Responsible for day to day financial affairs. Maintain the following parameters per key activity on a monthly basis: budget funds spent to date funds remaining. Signal possible budget overrun situations as early as possible. Represent our organisation in a presentable manner.
Time required	On average five hours per week. Daily check of e-mail received and response as required.
Characteristics	 Analytical. Organised. Accurate. Empathetic. Patient. Determined. Proactive. Motivated.
Knowledge and Skills	 MS-Office (Word, Excel and some limited Powerpoint). E-mail software such as Outlook and/or webmail. Dutch language spoken and written, as a first language.
